SASTRA: Shanmugha Arts, Science, Technology & Research Academy (SASTRA Deemed to be University) is a Category I University (University Grants Commissions Graded Autonomy Regulations 2018) offering Undergraduate, Postgraduate and Doctoral programmes in Engineering, Sciences, Education, Management, Law and Arts. A sprawling campus having a built-up area of 2,22,129.02 square meters spread over 232 acres and a vibrant population of students and teaching faculty have made SASTRA a landmark in the educational map of India.
