Applying a Shastri Award for a Second Time

There is no restriction for a Shastri existing awardee to apply or receive any other Shastri grants/awards, however, the following rules are applicable for applying/receiving a Shastri award for a second time.

1. *India Studies Arts Fellowships*

An individual who was awarded an India Studies Arts Fellowship may not apply for a further arts fellowship until at least three (3) years have passed. For example, an individual receiving a grant in 2010-11, will be eligible to apply for the same grant in 2014-15.

2. *India Studies Fellowships – Other Categories*

An individual who was awarded an India Studies Fellowship may not apply for a further fellowship for three years. For example, an individual receiving a grant in 2010-11, will be eligible to apply for the same grant in 2014-15.

3. *Canadian Studies Fellowships*

An individual who was awarded a Canadian Studies Fellowship may not apply for a further fellowship until at least three (3) years have passed. For example, an individual receiving a grant in 2010-11, will be eligible to apply for the same grant in 2014-15.

4. *Canadian Studies Program Development Grant*

An individual who was awarded a Canadian Studies Program Development Grant may not receive another such award until at least three (3) years have passed. For example, an individual receiving the Grant 2011-12, will be eligible to apply for the same grant in 2014-15.

5. *Canadian Studies Program Development Grant*

An individual who was awarded a Canadian Studies Program Development Grant may not receive another such award until at least three (3) years have passed. For example, an individual receiving the Grant 2011-12, will be eligible to apply for the same grant in 2014-15.

6. *Student Excellence Award*

An individual who was successfully awarded a Student Excellence Award may not re-apply for the same award at any time.

7. Lal Bahadur Shastri Award

An individual who was successfully awarded a Lal Bahadur Shastri Award may not reapply for the same award at any time.

8. Partnership Development Seed Grant

An individual who was awarded a Partnership Development Seed Grant (PDSG) may not receive another PDSG grant until at least two (2) years have passed. For example, an individual receiving a grant in 2010-11, will be eligible to apply for a second grant in 2013-14.

9. Millennium Development Research Grant

An individual who was awarded a Millennium Development Research Grant may not receive another Millennium Development Research Grant until at least three (3) years have passed. For example, an individual receiving a MDG grant in 2010-11 (for a two years project, i.e., to complete the project by 2011-12), will be eligible to apply for another MDG grant in 2015-16. However, if an individual receives a MDG grant in 2010-11 (for a one year project), will be eligible to reapply for the second time in 2014-15.

10. Scholar Travel Subsidy Grant

An individual who was awarded a Travel Subsidy Grant may not receive another Scholar Travel Subsidy Grant until at least one (1) year has passed. For example, an individual receiving a grant in 2010-11, will be eligible to apply for a second STSG grant in 2012-13.

11. Youth Internships

An individual may not apply for a further internship at any time.

12. Shastri Action Research Project Grant

An individual who was awarded a Shastri Action Research Grant may not receive another Shastri Action Research Grant until at least three (3) years have passed. For example an individual receiving an ARPG in 2010-11, will be eligible to apply for a second ARP grant in 2014-15.

13. Faculty Mobility Award

An individual who was awarded a Faculty Mobility Award may not receive another such award until at least three (3) years have passed. For example, an individual receiving a Faculty Mobility Award grant in 2010-11, will be eligible to reapply for the same in 2014-15

14. Student Mobility Award

A student may not apply for a second Student Mobility Award at any time.

15. Quebec Tuition Exemption for Indian Student

A student may not apply for a second Student Mobility Award at any time.

16. Visiting Lectureship Awards

- Indian Visiting Lecturer
- Shastri-Lester Pearson Memorial Lecturer
- Kanta Marwah Lecture Series
- Canadian Visiting Lecturer

An individual may not be considered for any of the above twice.

17. Collaborative Research Project

An individual who was awarded a Collaborative Research Project Award may not receive another such award until at least three (3) years have passed. For example, an individual receiving the Grant in 2010-11 and 2011-12 may not receive another such award until 2014-15
