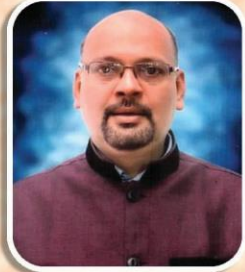
Shastri Indo-Canadian institution
