He is one of 78 new appointees to the 'Order of Canada'.

A fellow of the Royal Society of Canada and the Canadian Academy of Health Sciences, Hirdes is known for his research in geriatric assessment, mental health, health care and service delivery and health information management. He is the senior Canadian Fellow and a board member of interRAI, an international consortium of researchers from more than 40 countries.



SICI is currently facilitating Dr Hirdes and InterRAI in establishing its connections in India to grow its network and initiate and enhance collaborations with Indian institutions on "mental health issues".


University of Windsor

A partnership deal was signed between the Indian Institute of Technology Indore (IIT Indore) and the University of Windsor to advance engineering education and research through global collaboration. This transformative alliance will facilitate various initiatives, including exchanging scholars, professional staff, and students, fostering a rich exchange of ideas and expertise between the two esteemed institutions. Furthermore, joint research projects will be promoted, focusing on addressing complex challenges and pushing the boundaries of scientific innovation.

The partnership will also see the exchange of research materials and information, enhancing the resources available to researchers and facilitating the seamless flow of knowledge across borders. Additionally, both institutions will explore opportunities to develop joint academic degree programmes, offering students a unique educational experience that combines the strengths of IIT Indore and the University of Windsor.

Promotion of articulation programmes will provide students with clear pathways to transition between undergraduate and postgraduate studies at both institutions, empowering them to pursue advanced degrees in engineering. This partnership marks a significant step in fostering collaboration between India and Canada in engineering education and research, advancing knowledge and nurturing future engineering leaders at a global scale.


