

P C Deshmukh served the Indian Institute of Technology Madras for more than three decades and has now moved to the Indian Institute of Technology Tirupati where he is a Professor of Physics and Dean, Sponsored Research and Consultancy. He obtained his Ph.D. from the Nagpur University and worked for his post-doctoral research at the University of Aarhus, the University of Notre Dame, and also the Georgia State University. His interests lie in the field of quantum collision physics especially in atomic photoionization using relativistic many-body theory. PCD enjoys teaching both under-graduate and advanced courses in physics. Three of his 40-lectures courses are available online on the internet. Apart from guiding several Ph.D. students, and publishing many research papers in premier journals, he has engaged many under-graduate students in interesting physics projects. His research group is one of the major contributors to the study of attosecond time-delay in atomic photoionization.
