The University of Mysore was established in 1916. It was founded during the reign of Krishnaraja Wodeyar IV, the Maharaja of Mysore. The university became the first outside the British administration in India, the sixth in India as a whole, and the first in Karnataka.

There are 38 Foreign collaborations and 27 National collaborations. Enrollment of a large number of overseas students from 63 countries reflects the international reputation of the university.
